

Baskets of Promise

The Philippines is one of the most disaster prone countries in the world, experiencing 15-20 typhoons every year. Super Typhoon Haiyan, a category 5 typhoon, struck the Philippines on the morning of November 8 as one of the world's most powerful storms on record to make landfall. Lutheran World Relief (LWR) is currently reaching out to families affected by Typhoon Haiyan with Personal Care Kits. By assembling Personal Care Kits and participating in the LWR's Baskets of Promise Lenten campaign, we can provide basic sanitation and hygiene items for families coping with some of life's most difficult situations.

Items included in the Baskets of Promise Personal Care Kits include: one or two bars of soap (4-5oz., any brand, in original wrapping), comb, nail clipper (metal, attached file optional) and toothbrush (adult size, in original packaging) all wrapped in a bath towel (light-weight, maximum 52"x27", dark color recommended). Personal Care Kits can be dropped off in the atrium throughout the season of Lent, Ash Wednesday (March 5) through Good Friday (April 18).
